Before we begin the [Jefferson County ARES Net](#), does anyone need to use the repeater?

Calling the Jefferson County, ARES NET. This is (callsign) _____, convening the Jefferson County ARES NET at this time. My name is _____ and I am located in _____.

(PAUSE)

The Jefferson County ARES NET is a local-level net of the National Traffic System of the American Radio Relay League. This NET handles formal traffic into and out of the listening area of this repeater, promotes goodwill and fellowship among amateur radio operators, and demonstrates readiness to participate in the event of an emergency, and providing training to local amateur radio operators for emergency and public service communications.

In the event of a declared or undeclared emergency, all available operators are asked to stand by on this frequency for instructions. This is a directed NET, which means that all contacts should be made through net control, and stations should not leave the net without advising net control.

When checking in, please give your call sign phonetically, followed by your name and location, and state whether you have traffic for the NET.

(I dee and pause the repeater)

Are there stations with EMERGENCY or PRIORITY traffic?

(PAUSE)

All LIASONS from other nets, STATIONS WITH TRAFFIC, or STATIONS WITH ANNOUNCEMENTS please call now.

(PAUSE) (Recognize all.)

All EMERGENCY POWER, PORTABLE and MOBILE stations, please call now. (RECOGNIZE ALL) (CALL LIASON FOR COMMENTS!)

All District 6 Members of WV ARES or ARES members from our neighboring states. Please call now.
(RECOGNIZE ALL)

Any OTHER STATIONS wishing to check in please call now.
(PAUSE) (RECOGNIZE ALL)

This is your net control station _____. This completes the service portion of the Jefferson County ARES NET. The net is now declared informal and will continue for a short round of comments, starting with the Emergency Power, Portable and Mobile stations. Your comments are welcome and appreciated.

(Go down through check-ins by callsign and ask for comments.)

Are there any additional stations who would like to check in before we close the net?

(RECOGNIZE ALL)
(If no further check-ins, Close the Net)

We'd like to thank all stations who checked in to this evening's net. The Jefferson County ARES Net meets each Sunday at 8:30 p.m., on this WB8YZV repeater. In the event that this repeater is out of service we will meet on 147.540 megahertz Simplex.
